Jerry Busher and James Canty have been friends for almost twenty years. The list of D.C bands they have been involved in runs far and deep, including but not exclusive to, Nation of Ulysses, Make Up, Fidelity Jones, All Scars, Las Mordidas, and Fugazi. It was with the All Scars that Busher and Canty first collaborated, doing a 5 week, 8 country tour based solely around improvised music. Upon return to the states, they took the ideas and energy from that tour, and formed French Toast.

"In A Cave", French Toast's first full-length was released in March 2005 by Dischord Records. The band toured extensively in support of the album including dates in the States and Europe with bands as varied as Electrelane, Mono, Supersystem, Bloc Party, the Ponys and Wilco.

In 2006 French Toast expanded to a trio with the addition of Ben Gilligan from Small Doses, a band he started in Australia in 1998 before moving back to the U.S., his childhood home. He's also done time in The Vague (DC), and Presuming Ed.

In April 2006 French Toast entered Trixie studios with Brendan Canty to record the new songs they had written as a newly minted three piece. The resulting full-length, "Ingleside Terrace," brings even more depth to the the band's already eclectic pallet.
